- attachment. Include where they went and what they did. 2 points per sentence = 14 points

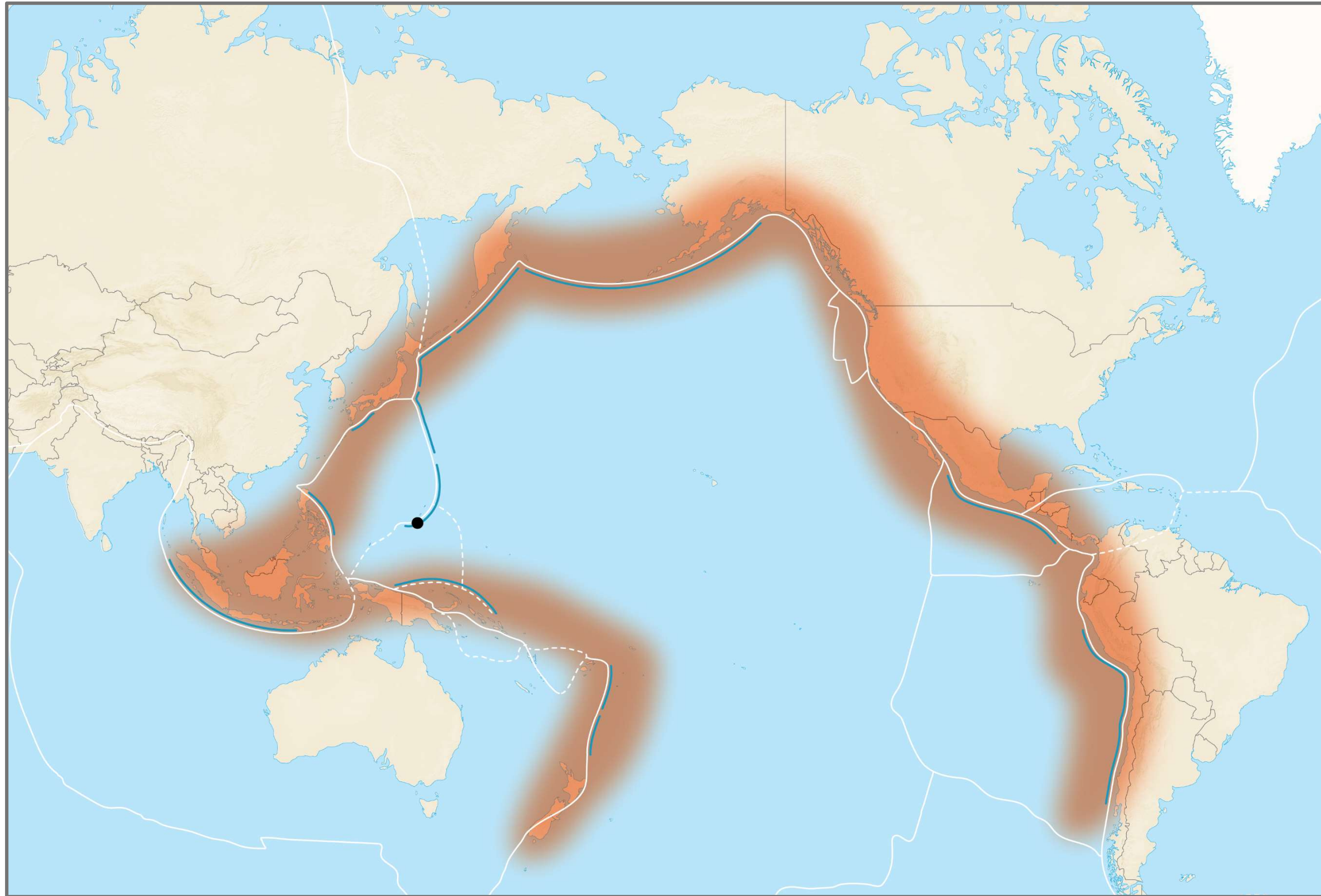
- Write three to four sentences about Buddhism in Southeast Asia. Include how it started and what Buddhists believe. 8 points
