

Threads PowerPoint files will open in presentation software other than Microsoft PowerPoint such as Google Slides, LibreOffice Impress, and Apple Keynote. However, various elements such as fonts, colors, and animations will fail to display correctly. We therefore recommend using Microsoft PowerPoint to use Weaving's presentation files.

- iPad – Install Microsoft 365 (Office) from the App Store. Once installed, you can open PowerPoint files from either your iPad's storage or from a cloud storage location. With a free Microsoft account, you can display but not edit the presentations. With a paid Microsoft 365 account, you can both display and edit the presentations.
- Mac – Install Microsoft PowerPoint from the App Store. Once installed, you can open PowerPoint files from either your Mac's storage or from a cloud storage location. With a free Microsoft account, you can display but not edit the presentations. With a paid Microsoft 365 account, you can both display and edit the presentations.
- Windows –
 - If you have a Microsoft 365 subscription, you can install PowerPoint by navigating to office.com, logging in, and clicking "Install apps." Once installed, you can easily open, present, and edit *Threads* presentations from the desktop app.
 - If you do not have a Microsoft 365 subscription, upload *Threads* PowerPoint files to a free Microsoft account at OneDrive.com. From OneDrive.com, you can open the PowerPoint files in the PowerPoint web app to view, present, and edit.
- Linux – PowerPoint's web app is the best way to access PowerPoint on Linux. Upload *Threads* PowerPoint files to OneDrive.com with either a free or paid Microsoft account. From OneDrive.com, you can open the PowerPoint files in the PowerPoint web app to view, present, and edit.
- ChromeOS – PowerPoint's web app is the best way to access PowerPoint on a Chromebook. Upload *Threads* PowerPoint files to OneDrive.com with either a free or paid Microsoft account. From OneDrive.com, you can open the PowerPoint files in the PowerPoint web app to view, present, and edit.
- Android - Install Microsoft 365 (Office) through Google Play. Once installed, you can open PowerPoint files from either your device's storage or from a cloud storage location.
